

Doctors see increase in demand for liposuction with the Tickle Lipo process.

A vibrating tip distracts patients from sensing pain; doctors say that they can sculpt more precisely. Tickle Lipo is an FDA approved device using non-laser technology to make the procedure easier on both the patient and the doctor.

Liposuction is in increasing demand as people wish to contour their abdomens, waists, “love handles”, even their necklines. In addition, reducing downtime for patients is an important consideration, as many people cannot afford to miss time from their busy schedules.

The Tickle Lipo device is becoming the instrument of choice for many physicians who are experienced in liposuction.

Tickle Lipo(<http://nilnow.com>) is also indicated for fat transfer procedures, which have grown in demand over the past two years. The process makes it possible to harvest high quality body fat without damage to surrounding tissue. The vibrating cannula glides through fatty tissue while simultaneously administering anesthesia to the body areas. Because of the maneuverability of the hand piece, it’s easier for doctors to navigate in sensitive body areas, resulting in a more smoothly sculpted body. Many doctors are reporting that they can perform high volume and precise fat removal, even in more difficult body areas such as the back.

Dr. Timothy Zelko, who practices in Chicago and Milwaukee has been performing and training physicians in office-based liposuction for 5 years. He has performed hundreds of procedures and has used every type of liposuction instrument available. After performing 120 Tickle Lipo cases, since July 2010, he is convinced that Tickle Lipo is the safest, most effective form of office-based liposuction, now referred to as Liposculpture.

Tickle Lipo is an FDA approved device that uses non-laser modality to make the procedure easier on both the patient and the doctor. The Tickle Lipo process is unique because of the tickling feeling that many patients feel during the procedure, rather than the pain associated with traditional liposuction. A special cannula that produces vibration causes the tickling sensation and tricks the nerves into thinking there’s no pain.

Dr. Laurence Weider is a board certified cosmetic plastic surgeon who has maintained a private practice in Dallas, Texas since 1999. He performs cosmetic surgery of the body and face, specializing in breast augmentation, body contouring procedures such as liposuction, and facial rejuvenation techniques like the face lift. Dr. Weider says that he plans to use Tickle Lipo for all his liposuction cases.
